Clothes Shopping Guide

PLEASE SEE THE WCS HANDBOOK FOR THE FULL DRESS CODE

- Shirts need to cover the shoulders, chest, back and be long enough to overlap pants.
 - Layering is encouraged—items like cardigans, camisoles or undershirts can be paired with tops and dresses to make them school-appropriate.
 - Sheer tops may be worn only when layered over a shirt that meets dress code.
 - Clothing should reflect positive values and avoid graphics or brands that conflict with the school's Christian standards. No skulls, weapons, alcohol or drug paraphernalia, gore or horror logos, or secular bands/artists.
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- All bottoms should fit comfortably and allow ease of movement- nothing overly tight or low-waisted.
 - Distressed styles are allowed as long as any rips or tears are at or below the knee.
 - Shorts need to be mid-thigh length or longer at all times, even while seated.
 - Skirts and dresses need to reach the top of the knee.
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- Hair color is to be within the spectrum of natural tones.
 - Extreme hair styles are not permitted. No cut-in designs, mohawks, man buns.
 - Boys' hair needs to be off their collar and out of their eyes.
 - Girls' makeup can be worn in a way that is neat and natural.
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- Hats may be worn on campus with the bill facing forward.
- Girls may wear up to three earrings per ear. Boys are not to have piercings.
- No undergarments are to be visible.
- Shoes must be worn at all times; sandals are welcome.
- Jackets need to have a dress code appropriate shirt underneath.
