INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL STUDENT PLEDGE

- 1. I understand that when I am traveling abroad, I represent my home, my school, and Jesus Christ. My conduct, words and attitude will always reflect my relationship with the Lord.

- 6. Regarding my passport, tickets, and ID
 - A. I will be responsible and not lose my passport, ticket, or ID.
 - B. I will make a copy of my passport and keep it in a safe place.
 - C. I understand that if I lose my passport I will not be able to continue on the trip but will have to return to the United States at my own expense.
 - D. I understand that in the very unlikely event of losing my passport while abroad, I will be responsible for all costs associated with getting a new one. This may include passport fees, flight changes and hotel costs for me and a chaperone.
- 7. I agree to follow all of the directions and guidelines expected of me during the trip.
 - A. No student or adult chaperone may consume or purchase alcohol for the duration of the trip.
 - B. Profanity may not be used at any time by students or adults.
 - C. Boys and girls, men and women, are not allowed in the rooms of the opposite sex at any time.
 - D. Students must be in groups of three or more during free time.
 - E. Participation in all group activities is required.
 - F. Students and adults must stay within school dress code or appropriate modifications made only by the main group leader. To show respect for the culture we are visiting, additional dress code policies may be in place as given to you by your leader. Additionally, one-piece, modest bathing suits may be worn when appropriate.
 - G. Students must adhere to nightly curfews and remain in their assigned rooms after stated curfew.
