

Clothes Shopping Guide

HONORING GOD IN ALL WE DO

These rules do not represent all of the WCS Dress Code, but are meant as a guide to help when shopping for clothing. For a complete listing of the WCS dress code please see the WCS Handbook.

Students should learn to make choices regarding clothing and appearance that attract attention to one's personal countenance rather than one's physical appearance.

The clothing and appearance of WCS students should be pleasing to God and show respect for people.

Student choices regarding clothing and appearance should arise from character qualities of the heart such as modesty, cleanliness, deference, discretion, wholesomeness, self-control, propriety, obedience, and safety.

- Companies to avoid: RIPNDIP, Odd Future, PINK, and Famous Stars & Straps (and any other companies who do not represent the Christian values our school upholds).
- Do not wear clothing with skulls, weapons, or logos of secular bands.
- All shirts must have sleeves and cover the shoulders.
- Sheer garments of any kind must be worn over another top that is within the dress code (shoulders covered, undergarments unseen).
- Shirts cannot be too tight or revealing. Stomachs and backs should not be showing at any time, even when reaching/bending. Crop tops may be worn if an undershirt covers the midriff at all times.
- Cardigan “cover-up” sweaters help provide girls with options to keep a variety of outfits within the dress code.

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- Jeans should be clean and neat. Holes no larger than a quarter are permitted at or below the knee.
 - Jeans/skirts/dresses should not be too tight and should not be able to be described as a “snug fit”.
 - Yoga pants/jeggings/leggings are not allowed.
 - Skirts/dresses must come to the top of the knee at all times and have no rips/tears.
 - Shorts must be to mid-thigh at all times.

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- Hair color must be natural hair colors.
 - Hair should be neat in style and moderate in trim avoiding extreme fads. Hair length cannot cover the eyes. Mohawks, faux hawks, “cut-in designs”, man buns, or other extreme styles are not permitted.
 - Make-up should be stylish and neat but avoiding extreme fads.
 - Baseball hats are allowed on campus as long as they are “bill forward.”
 - Boys: Piercings are not allowed at school or at any school function.
 - Girls: May wear up to three earrings in each ear.
 - Shoes must be worn on campus at all times. Sandals are acceptable.
