- II. To determine if you qualify for California Scholarship Federation, follow these guidelines:
 - a. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
 - b. Courses you may use are listed on the attached sheet. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.
 - i. The first 4 points must be from LIST I.
 - ii. The first 7 points (including the 4 points from LIST I) must be from LISTS I and II.
 - iii. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II or III).
 - c. You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify. THERE ARE 17 POINTS MAXIMUM.
 - d. *NO* CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, teacher assistant, subjects repeated to improve a grade, summer courses, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
 - e. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - i. A grade of an "A" = 3 CSF points.
 - ii. A grade of a "B" = 1 CSF point.
 - iii. 1 additional CSF point shall be granted for a grade of an "A" or "B" in AP or Honors courses from lists I and II ONLY, up to a maximum of 2 such points per semester. (List III courses and College/Dual Enrollment courses are NOT eligible for extra points.)
 - iv. A grade of a "C" = 0 CSF points.
 - v. A grade of a "D" or "F" in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership for this semester.
 - f. Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous* semester.
 - g. You must **reapply each semester with a fee of \$15** that will be due with the application.
