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May 29-30 Graduation Practices

Senior graduation practices will be held on May 29 & 30. May 29 we will have graduation practice from 8:30am-1pm at WCS. On May 30, we will have practice at Harvest Christian Fellowship at 9am-1pm. May 30 Graduation

WCHS Senior Graduation will be at Harvest Christian Fellowship on May 30 at 7pm. **Seniors must arrive at 6pm** and the doors will open for seating at 6pm. The ceremony will last approximately 2 hours.

Graduation Seating

Each graduating senior will receive four reserved seating tickets at the end of graduation practice for the graduation ceremony on May 30. This entitles the bearer to a seat in the lower reserved section at Harvest Christian Fellowship. Other guests may attend the ceremony but will be seated on a first come first served basis in the rest of the sanctuary and balcony.

Solemnity of the Graduation Ceremony

The WCHS graduation ceremony seeks to honor the Lord, our parents, and our students. As such, we work very hard to create an atmosphere that celebrates this special occasion and honors the sanctity of Harvest Christian Fellowship as well. 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Senior Speeches 2019

Write a speech consisting of 300-500 words that would be appropriate to give at graduation. This is a persuasive speech, one that reflects your heart attitude. Your audience is your class of peers, your parents, family, and guests, the faculty and administration of WCS, and the school board.

Address one of the following or similar topics:

How has your time at Woodcrest Christian had a positive impact on your life? How has God orchestrated the events of your life or that of your classmates to impact the world for Christ?

What will your graduating class be remembered for and what will they accomplish?

This speech could be written about one or two friends, teachers, or family members who have had a significant impact on you. It could be about how some extracurricular activity (athletics, clubs, etc.) has prepared you for college or entering your vocation. It could also be about any of these persons and how they had an influence on your Christian character.

This speech is not a "shout out" speech.

If you choose to write about friends, teachers, and/or family, limit your reference to one or two people and give specific examples.

Be creative and make the speech interesting! Be exciting and creative. Use quotes or personal stories. Use Scripture or biblical truth. Use a hook. Perhaps an extended metaphor to create interest.

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Graduation Musical Performance 2019

Graduation night presents an opportunity to honor the Lord in music. This opportunity is an important aspect of the entire graduation evening and one that helps set the mood and the standard for the evening. As such, musical groups being considered for a performance must meet the following criteria:

- The school has a strong preference for Christian music that is honoring to the Lord and uplifting;
- Secular music *may* be accepted if the content supports Christian values and the artist and the original intent of the song does not violate biblical truth/values;
- The words/song should be of noble character;
- The words must be understandable when sung;
- The overall quality of the performance (including singing, instrument playing, and stage presence) must be excellent. The selected group(s) must be willing to attend additional practices under the auspices of WCS staff to meet the expected performance levels.

The names of your musical performance group, the song you plan to sing and the lyrics are due to Mrs. Sheffer in the HS office on Wednesday May 1, 2019

The selected musical pieces must be in near polished condition for auditions scheduled for Friday May 15, 2019 at 3pm in the Choir Room.
