## GPA Computation

The GPA is calculated by adding the product of the course's credits and the grade points earned and then dividing by the total number of qualifying credits.

- GPA = all subject grades 9-12
  - AP denotes Advanced Placement and receives 1.0 extra weight\*\*
  - Honors denotes advanced course and receives 1.0 extra weight\*\*
  - Woodcrest Christian basic course credits have recently been adjusted by one-half grade point average to reflect the rigor completed within our college prep courses.

## School Overview

Woodcrest Christian High School (WCHS) provides a ministry of Christ-centered Academics for grades 9-12 that is evangelical, interdenominational, co-educational, and college preparatory. The core of every academic subject is founded on Jesus Christ, “in whom are all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge” (Colossians 2:3). Thus our mission is to Glorify God by Pursuing Excellence in Christ-centered Academics. The academic program provides a curriculum that meets or exceeds the entrance requirements of Christian colleges and universities and the University of California.

Located on a 30-acre campus in the city of Riverside, WCHS was opened in 1973. Along with Woodcrest Christian Day School, which was founded in 1948, these schools form the Woodcrest Christian School System (TK–12) and operate as a California religious non-profit 501(c)3 corporation.
